PICTURE DESCRIPTION	PICTURE
Looking south east from Whirly Road towards trees T13 and T14 of the AIA	
Stem base of T14 (Mature Ash) tree exhibits good vitality however audible signs of internal hollowing detected to a height of 2 metres from ground level to north west side of stem and likely extends to below point at which crown forks. Internal cavity at stem base extends some 700mm	
Tree T8 (oak) of AIA, exhibits good vitality aerially but quantities of ingrown barbed wire and extensive hollowing to stem base clearly visible, access restricted to assess stem in more detail but audible hollowing detected to east side of stem to a height of 2 metres.	

Group G3 – planting mix favours pioneer species – birch but contains alder, oak, maple, hawthorn and cherry with blackthorn, willow , hazel and guelder rose
