The Millennium Green is a beautiful green space next to the church, in the centre of the village. It is actively managed and maintained by the Millennium Green Trust, whose primary aim is to maintain the Green in its current form, in perpetuity, for the inhabitants of Henbury. The Green includes a childrens' play area, picnic area and a wildflower meadow. It has been planted with hundreds of trees, and is used for community events such as the Summer Fete and Bonfire, and by various groups including local schools and scout groups for outdoor activities and adventures. The Green is also home to a large, specially commissioned Millennium Sundial, which has been aligned by the former Astronomer Royal.

- From the wildflower meadow
  - Docks at the beginning of the season

### What's Been Removed from the Green This year?

- Woodland areas
  - Trees when they get too tall or close to overhead power lines
  - Trees / bushes when they grow too close together and block light from other plants

This wood is then used for the bonfire

- Apple Tree Pruning
  - Expert advice sought from Julie Ward
  - Trees pruned to maintain healthy crops



### What's Been Removed from the Green This year?

- Sharp and Prickly Things
  - Brambles in woodland areas (when cutting down other things in the area)
  - Nettles but only where they cause an issue, ie close to the willow structure or underneath the apple trees at harvest time.

- Path clearance
  - Brushing / scraping
