It was reported that:

The Chairman, Mr Royce Batters, had written to Cheshire East Council (CEC) objecting to their proposals. This letter had been copied to the Henbury Society who were doing their own research into the matter. So

far no there had been no response from CEC.

Mr Christopher Dafforn had been appointed as a Trustee for the Children's Play Area.

An application for single storey side and rear extensions at a property on William Way was recommended for approval by CEC.

There would be a budgeted deficit for 2012/13 approaching £2,500 (See later). Consequently there would need to be an increase in the Precept. Even then there was likely to be a deficit for the forthcoming year. Costs would need to be cut. One measure proposed and agreed was to cancel

the usual grant (£500) to the Millennium Green Trust. It was hoped that this could be reinstated when funds allowed.

A resident had written requesting that the speed limit on Andertons Lane be reduced to 30 or even to 20mph. The resident was concerned because there had been considerably more cycle traffic on the lane recently. This matter would be referred to CEC for their comments.

It was reported that the hedge on the west side of Pepper Street had been cut back. Disappointment was expressed that it had not been cut back further to be in line with the edge of the wall.
