### Cheshire East Local Plan

The Inspector will continue his inquiry this autumn, after receiving further proposals for revisions from CE planners. CE has not yet specified the additional sites which will be needed to meet the requirements of the Inspector; there remains a possibility that proposals will be made to use Green Belt land between Henbury and Macclesfield. Roger Cousin, Chairman of the Henbury Society, has set out the situation in an [excellent paper](#) which is already available on the Henbury website. The PC recommends a wide circulation of this paper.

### Road Safety

The PC is concerned about increasing traffic, especially on Church Lane and Andertons Lane. Cyclists on Andertons Lane frequently travel too fast, and often in large groups, downhill from the Whirley Lane end, meeting traffic round blind and narrow bends. There is no speed restriction on this road. This situation will be presented at an Area Highways Group on Sept 30, but the PC will also propose warning signs directed especially at Cyclists.

### Footpaths
